## **COSTA DELLE PARRACINE, THE BEAUTY OF THE SEA AND THE POWER OF THE LAND**

The Parracine, dry stone walls that the island's master stonemasons have been erecting for centuries, are made of the precious green tuff stone extracted from Mount Epomeo.

Although built to demarcate the land and protect Ischia's crops and vineyards from the wind and bad weather, over time they have become a distinguishing feature of the island and indicate many pathways that tourists can follow. Costa delle Parracine aims to express the extraordinary complexity of the island of Ischia – a complexity born from the intensity of its volcanic soils and the rich minerality that nourishes the vineyards.

The estate, located in the Forio area, has a history that goes back a long way as testified by the marvellous wine cellar dated 1878 dug out of the green tuff of Mount Epomeo, where the winemaking and ageing of the wines takes place. Its vineyards, planted in the early 2000s, cover around 4 hectares of land and overlook the sea.

Thanks to its array of aromas, the Forastera variety produces a pleasant well-balanced wine.
